In celebration of Women's month, Reisa hosted the second Young Women In Business Programme, held in early August. Fifty female entrepreneurs based in the Gamagara Local Municipality were selected to take part in this three-day training workshop.

The programme, implemented by our service partners, Angels Resource Centre and Lead Academy, provided participants with business skills training, business planning and goal setting. Furthermore, it helped to equip and empower these entrepreneurs to succeed by supplying them with business start-up kits.

The training also included a Lean Canvas workshop, with guest speakers from SARS, in addition to a workshop focused on writing a business plan with guest speakers from the Small Enterprise Development Agency (SEDA). The training concluded with a networking session and a celebratory luncheon.


