graduation ceremony in Kathu hosted by the REISA Hub.

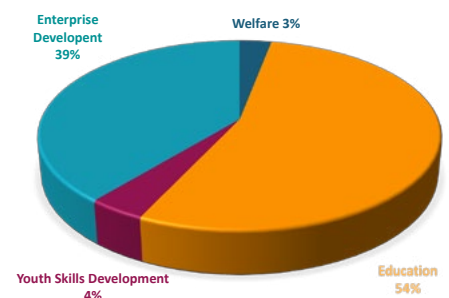
We are honoured to have "Imbokodo" as part of our local SMME community.
