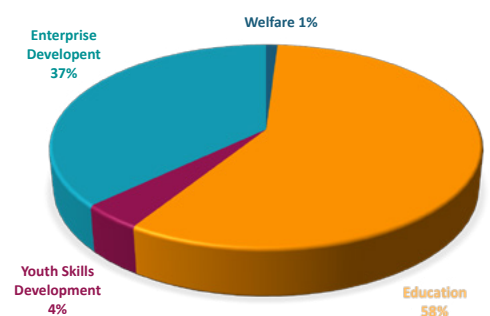


UBUNTU WELLNESS PROJECT EMPOWERS YOUNG BOYS
